The last day of June proved pleasantly warm and free of rain as thirteen Ramblers gathered

path by the Scoonie Burn to reach the far end of this scenic glen. From there we crossed the main road, now heading towards the shoreline and then back to Silverburn via Leven Promenade and the final stretch of beach. The café at Silverburn with its outdoor seating provided the perfect ending to this very enjoyable walk.

Our next walk is on Wednesday 10th July, a 6.5-mile linear walk on farm tracks and minor roads from Dairsie via Fingask and Denbrae to Cairnie, finishing at Cupar.
