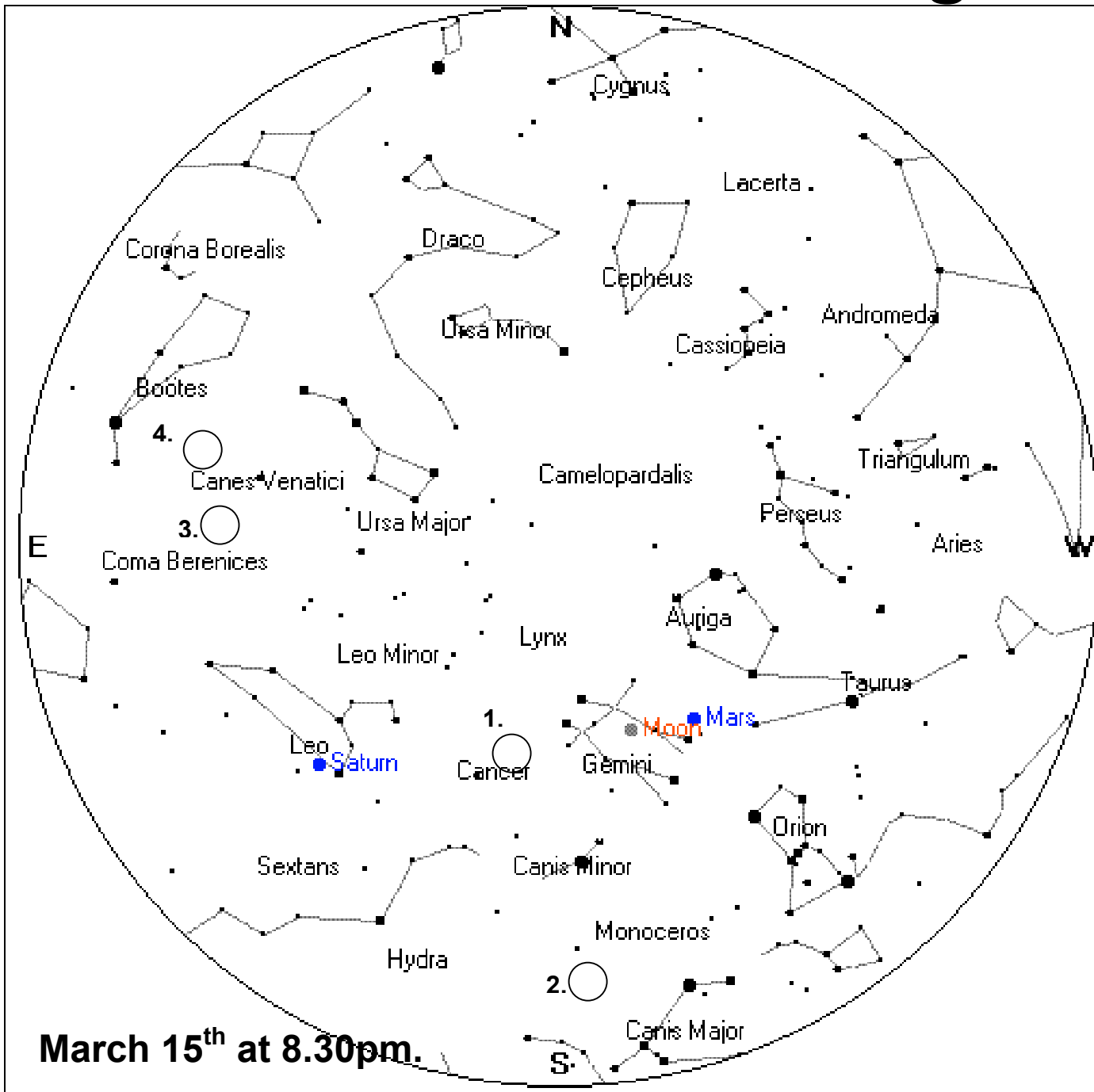


Bill's Binocular Targets For March.



March 15th at 8.30pm.

Target number 1, M44

Big naked eye cluster 15 degrees south east of Pollux.

M44 looks much better in binoculars through in a telescope.

Target number 2, M46 and 47

Two open clusters 8 degrees east of Sirius. M47 can be seen with the naked eye in good clear skies. Try to see the planetary nebula in M46 with a telescope.

Target number 3, Melotte 111

A huge naked eye open cluster only 300 light years away. Find Denebola at the tail of Leo and move 15 degrees towards the end of the handle of the Plough. Search round about with a telescope and you may find some galaxies.

Target number 4, M3

A globular cluster halfway between Cor Caroli and Arcturus. Cor Caroli is the bright star lying 90 degrees from the last

two stars in the handle of the Plough.
