8) Planning & Licensing (RS)

All circulated

Council discussed the number of water tankers/day

MB advised there is a blockage in the reservoir, so water is not getting into the treatment plant. More water to be tankered throughout the year, exceptional to be filling at this time of year.

Concerns of limited supply as it currently stands.

MB advised Lairg Road pipe leaking, may need to open other side of the road

NM advised that years ago no new housing was allowed because of lack of water - future developments should come from springs or bore holes.

The Council asked MB to speak to Scottish Water. HB to formally request this and also raise the issue of GI Works, Carron Place in Ardgay - tap/drinking water being used to keep drills cool - 8-10,000 litres a day

Why not use water from Loch Buidhe?

Strong argument against the development of BESS = lack of water

Numerous complaints going to HC Chief Exec re state of roads in Highlands

Road dressing not done last year intend to do a great portion of that this year

"Westies Road" is on capital road programme plus the road by Robert Sawyer

20 mph issue went to full regulation. Some areas still have 30mph on road, these will be burnt out

- •Acheilidh MB advised this is going in front of full council on 29th May, planning committee was a 5-5 vote. Chair's vote went with officers' recommendation of no refusal but the motion against it got sufficient votes, and it was agreed to bring back to full council

The developers would like community consultation at a future meeting of 30 minutes, for a 5–10-minute presentation, with 20 minute Q&A. Presentation will include visualisations. Wait until September for invitation to present.

• Achany extension just come in - to be circulated to councillors.

18 turbines, 81MGW (formerly Glen Cassley) consented by Scottish Ministers in 2023. Developers want to increase the height of turbines, scoping report will be submitted shortly



to ECU. Formal consultation and consenting process will follow. Scoping report will be shared with the community council.

SP - they want to put in a BESS - lots more pylons, higher turbines - disallowed previously due to impact. They say what was passed is not economically viable anymore. There was no BESS in the previous submission.

Consented section 36 to be modified to put new turbines into plans

HB attended an event only two people there wanted community benefit to be shared nationally. Majority feel that community benefit should remain local. Regional pot should be an additional payment perhaps

Maree Todd at the meeting was asked if Gillian Martin and Dr Alasdair Allan could meet with NoRos but this was refused as Noros is a protest group. Maree Todd was then asked if they would meet with the community councils, she said she would put that to them.

HB to write to MT to invite them to meet with community councils

MoP asked re Stonehenge toilets, Bonar Bridge, what is the position on overnight parking? No restriction on overnight parking. Toilets are closed and have been taken off HC map online and physical signage blanked out.

MB advised that the council is not reopening the toilets due to blocked pipes and vandalism Men's shed looking at the toilets as a possible men's shed

MB to ask HC for evidence of vandalism

The council discussed the fire at Rogart Vets and the time it took for the Fire Service to arrive. Engines need 4 people to respond to a call out before the engine can leave.

- BT applications approved £5,000 core funding for Kyle of Sutherland Hub, £2, 200 for Bradbury centre painting
