Glascairn Community Project Update	<ul> <li>a. Progress report on CU1 – Paper 1 The Board had a very positive meeting with Tulloch Homes on 24<sup>th</sup> March. An updated integrated design is being prepared by Tulloch Homes. Work is ongoing towards a Legal Agreement that would deal with the possible land swap to allow the SUDS area to be at the lowest point on the site. Before continuing to develop the proposals the Board agreed that there should be further consultation with the community to allow new information to be shared and questions answered (see (e)). The Community development is integral to the whole site and Legal Advice will be needed before any final agreement. The purchase of the land was through grant funding from Scottish Land Fund so Penny will contact SLF to check if there are any issues regarding a land swap to allow the whole site development to work more effectively.</li> <li>b.
