Glascairn Community Project Update	Culbokie Green Funding for the green is now in place, and a funding application for the Shelter has been submitted to the Place Based Investment Programme. As timescales are tight the Board agreed to allocate surplus THC funds for some preliminary work on the Shelter, subject to THC approval. A teacher at Culbokie primary is keen to involve pupils in tree planting, bumblebee nests and developing the wild flower areas.	
	Community Hub buildings An application has been made to the Place Based Investment Fund for a contribution towards the building warrant costs.	
Active Travel Project	Inception meeting with SUSTRANS and THC took place last week. THC will now manage the project. A Press Release is being prepared	
CCCC - update	Regular cycles continue. A six week 'couch to 20km' course is being planned for March/ April and more Cycle Maintenance courses will be scheduled for the coming months.	
Fundraising	Calendars 110 sold with the remainder reduced to £5 each. All costs have been covered. Cards 195 sold and the remainder will be advertised as blank cards. Quiz Night – planned for 26 th February in Findon Hall	
Sharing Shed	Many donations have been made over the festive period and use continues to grow. Excess or unused items are taken to charity shops or the Dingwall Food Bank as appropriate so nothing is wasted. New notices have been placed on the donations bins to remind folk that items need to be clean, indate and that there is no facility to clean and display 2 nd hand clothing/shoes etc. There are now 132 members on the Facebook group.	

Culbokie Community Market	Dec market was busy and went well although not many folk made use of the café.
