Who is Culbokie Community Trust?

Culbokie Community Trust (CCT) is a charity and limited company that exists for the benefit of everyone in the Culbokie area. Anyone on the electoral register is eligible to be a full voting member and we also have junior, business and associate membership categories.

Our objectives include:

- Managing community land and assets
- Providing recreation facilities and activities
- Community development
- Education about the environment, culture and heritage
- Environmental protection

What personal information do we collect, how do we collect it and how do we use it?

We collect the following information.

Market Café groups	Name, phone number, e-mail	Group requests to participate	To promote vacant café slots to local groups and charities as fundraising opportunity

Volunteers	Name, e-mail address	Individual requests to participate	To promote activities of the group
Culbokie Community Cycling Club	Name, address, email, health conditions, emergency contact details	Individual request to participate and completion of membership form	To promote activities of the group.

Lawful basis for collecting information

There are six possible lawful bases for collecting information as follows - **consent; contract; legal obligation; vital interests; public task; or legitimate interests**. The two that are most relevant to CCT are:

1. Consent – the individual has given clear consent for us to process their personal data for a specific purpose.
2. Legitimate interests - the processing is necessary for our legitimate interests

The lawful basis for each of our data lists is as follows:

Data List	Lawful basis	Reason
CCT Members/Friends	Legitimate interest	Anyone who joins and continues to retain their membership of CCT would reasonably expect us to use their data to contact them with news of our activities
Volunteers and other individuals who are not members	Consent	This dataset is not backed up by implicit membership consent
Culbokie Community Market Stallholders	Legitimate interest	The Culbokie Community Market is part of CCT's charitable activities and depends on good communications with stallholders
Culbokie Community Market promotion group	Consent	This dataset has unknown origins and is used mainly for marketing purposes
Market Café groups	Legitimate interest	The Market Café is part of CCT's charitable activities and depends on good communications with groups and charities that are running it
Volunteers	Consent	Everyone individual on this list has given clear consent for their name and contact details to be held. Consent can be withdrawn at any time.
Culbokie Community Cycling Club	Consent	Everyone individual on this list has given clear consent for their details to be held. Consent can be withdrawn at any time.

Who do we share personal information with?

We do not share personal information with anyone. In the future we may use an online service to deliver newsletters electronically. If we do this we will ensure that they are GDPR compliant.

How long we retain personal information?

Membership - We retain personal information for as long as an individual remains a member. If someone ceases to be a member we will delete their personal information within 3 months.

Market Stallholders - We will retain market stallholder information for as long as a business plays an active role in the market. We will delete information within three months on request.

Consents, where required, will be renewed every 3 years

Your rights

Anyone on our data lists has a right to ask for access to their personal information and to ask us to correct any inaccurate information or to delete their information if they believe we no longer need it or their consent has been withdrawn. We will deal with any such requests within 30 days.

Security

Information from membership forms and consent requests will be recorded electronically and any paper records will be shredded. Electronic data will be available only to Directors and key staff or volunteers who need the information to perform their role.

Any security issues will be minor because of the limited amount of information we hold. However if there is a breach in security, all those who have been affected will be informed immediately
