Famous For 22 Minutes

The bus service between Chilton and Newbury returned on 24 July. Last time we had buses to Newbury they meandered around the Ilsleys and other Berkshire villages and took a long time. The new X34 service goes straight down the A34 from Chilton and stops only at the Vodafone roundabout before arriving in Newbury town centre 22 minutes later. The buses, which also serve Didcot, run hourly most of the day Mondays to Saturdays. The X34 timetable is attached.

Most of the buses serve the centre of Chilton village. All the buses serve the Garden Centre bus stops on the A4185, including those which do not do the circuit through the old village. The printed timetable booklets leave a blank for those buses which do not go through the village, as do the electronic versions on the website, but the timetable displays at the Garden Centre bus stops do have times, around 15 minutes after leaving the Vodafone roundabout in the northbound direction! The bus company did tell us they have not made the Garden Centre stops a timing point as, if the bus arrives early after its dash along the A34, they don't want it hanging around the bus stop waiting time, and possibly frustrating passengers going to appointments at Harwell Campus.

Northbound, the X34's route through Didcot after Harwell village is via Great Western Park and the A4130 to Didcot Parkway railway station. It then does a lap of Didcot via Haydon Road, the Broadway, and the Orchard Centre before returning to Didcot Parkway station and starting its journey back to Newbury via the A4130 and Great Western Park.

TRAVEL TO OXFORD

The X32 route has been truncated to serve just the northern part of the route, between John Radcliffe Hospital, Oxford city centre and Didcot. Formerly it continued to Harwell Campus and Wantage, with a couple of journeys diverted through Chilton village.

The bus company's explanation is the service became unreliable because of congestion in east Oxford, and the decision was taken to turn it around at Didcot Parkway station.

The bus company's suggestion for journeys from Chilton to Oxford on Mondays to Fridays is to change into the ST1* buses at Harwell Campus. Most of the X34 and ST1 buses are timed for a 10 minute connection at the Campus.

The ST1 runs to Oxford via Milton Heights, the A34, Redbridge Park and Ride, Iffley Road, the University Science Area and Wadham College in Parks Road. It returns from Broad Street and the same route to Harwell Campus.

The summary timetable for X34 and ST1 connections is attached.

On Saturdays the advice is to change at Didcot Parkway station for the X32s to Oxford.

* ST stands for Science Transit, linking the Campus with the University of Oxford (Brains Bus in other words).

TRAVEL TO WANTAGE

The existing two morning services from Chilton to Wantage, returning in the afternoon, remain. Formerly route 34, they have been renumbered 43 to avoid confusion with the X34s. We wouldn't want schoolchildren ending up in Newbury when they thought they were on a bus to Wantage!

The timetable for this service is also attached.

94 - THE ALTERNATIVE ROUTE TO DIDCOT

The route 94 buses continue on their way to Didcot via Blewbury. There has been a plan to replace the route with Demand-Responsive Transport (DRT) where passengers book in advance, but Oxfordshire County Council have been talking about it for a long time and appear to be cooling to the idea.

The timetable for the 94s is attached.

All in all, Chilton now has an excellent bus service, much better than many villages in the county. The adult fare continues to be capped at a maximum of £2, and concessionary bus passes are accepted. The Parish Council hopes you will take advantage of what is on offer.

Hayleigh had a great time watching the live music at Bands on the Boundary in Boundary Park, Didcot - what a great atmosphere! Debra enjoyed attending the Beacon Open Day in Wantage, showcasing all the Beacon has to offer, and an evening of Ladies Wine and Tapas in Upton Village Hall. This month we've had briefings on the new Oxford railway station, the Valley Park housing development, Harwell Campus development, foul water and surface water drainage (ask us anything!) and as part of her cabinet role, Debra has had a tour of the leisure centres of the Vale. Council News

Full Council meeting held: on Wednesday 12th July at the Beacon in Wantage. The agenda can be found on the Vale of White Horse District Council website. Hayleigh asked Cllr Andy Crawford (Cabinet member for Finance and Property) for an update on the Great Western Park GP surgery following a paper brought to cabinet on 23rd June that was confidential. Cllr Crawford kindly responded:

"I recognise the provision of the new GP surgery for Great Western Park is very important to local residents and as a council we endeavour to be as open and transparent about all our activities as we are able to. I am disappointed we were not able to make the report of 23 June public due to it being subject to the finalisation of commercially sensitive transactions, involving other parties. The decision by members to consider the report in private session was based on the advice of the council's Monitoring Officer. A Communication and Engagement Plan has been prepared with input from all parties to establish a joint approach to proactive communications. This Plan has been shared with the ward councillors for Great Western Park. The plan identifies stages and methods for updates to relevant stakeholders and members of the public, which includes the publication of updates to a joint webpage created by the Vale and Integrated Care Board.

A Reflection from Revd Jeremy Parsons

It's been a whirl, these first few weeks as Rector of Harwell and Chilton. We've met so many new people, we've found so much going on here and we already feel very much at home. We're so grateful for such a warm welcome in the parishes, both from the churches and from the wider community. Thank you! In the Church of England, the term *curate* comes from a word meaning someone responsible for the care (or "cure") of others. At the service where I officially became the Rector, Bishop Gavin said these words:

Receive this cure of souls, which is both yours and mine; in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

There's an amazing team in our two churches. There's evidence of that fact in the range of activities we're involved with: seen in the round, our Sunday services are an important part, but quite a small part, of the work we do as a church. All of that work is a further sharing of that duty of care, that "cure of souls."

Someone once asked Jesus which of the commandments God gave comes first? Here's his answer:

The first one is this: "Listen, Israel: the Lord your God, the Lord is one; and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your understanding, and with all your strength." And this is the second one: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself."

This is the foundation of all Christian care: loving God with our whole selves and loving our neighbours as we love our own selves. A few weeks into my new role, I have seen so much evidence of this foundation of love at work, and so much positive collaboration between the church and the many other institutions and groups at work in these villages. I'm inspired by all that I've seen, and I'm excited for all that lies ahead.

Thanks again for the warmth of your welcome. And if we haven't yet spoken, I look forward to meeting you, perhaps at one of the events you'll see listed.
