#### **Village Brown Bin**

Oxfordshire County Council in recent years has reduced or abandoned the cutting of grass verges and road sweeping in the village.

If any public-spirited residents wish to weed, trim back or tidy an area of the village in the public domain a Parish Council brown bin is available in which to place the waste generated. Additionally householders are reminded that hedges that overhang footpaths should be trimmed regularly.

The Parish brown bin is located at Layton Cottage, Main Street in the custody of Keith and Jane Woods. If you wish to use it, please call 831750 to arrange this and to check that it is not in use, or indeed already full. This bin is not for your private garden waste, but

merely for weeds, trimmings and similar debris (but no soil) from public areas.

Volunteer work undertaken so far includes collecting cut grass from the upper green in Main Street, weed removal, cutting back foliage on Church Hill, the underpass path, Jubilee Bridge, planted tree maintenance around the Playbuilder area and on Lower Road.
