However it was felt that Cllr Geary required more support from Stanton under Bardon representatives.

	ALLOTMENTS
78/24-25	RESOLVED: The Council adopted the bee keeping policy for tenants requesting to keep bees on their allotment plot owned by Stanton under Bardon Parish Council following three further amendments:
	 That as an alternative to being a member of a recognised Bee Keeping Association affiliated to the British Beekeepers Association, the beekeeper can also take out their own public liability insurance policy and evidence this to the PC as part of their application to keep bee hives on their allotment plot That the fence around the hive should be 1.5 metres high. That any honey produced is not sold for profit
79/24-25	RESOLVED: The Council approved the request by an allotment tenant to replace a greenhouse with a polytunnel on an allotment plot at St John Cole Crescent allotments on provision of further details regarding how the polytunnel will be affixed to the ground.
	COMMUNITY PROJECTS
80/24-25	RESOLVED: The Council agreed to install a 6 metre ground mounted flagpole outside of Stanton under Bardon Village Hall. It was agreed that it would be sited on Parish Council owned land.
81/24-25	RESOLVED: The Council discussed the future management of car parking spaces on St John Cole Crescent and agreed to install parking signs stating "Parking for Village Hall Users only" to prevent un-authorised parking.
82/24-25	RESOLVED: The Council agreed to authorise the closure of Stanton under Bardon Village Hall Trust. It was noted that the Trust were in the process of ending contractual commitments with suppliers and there will be a requirement for the Council to put new suppliers in place.
