RURAL POLICING UPDATE

The police spoke about rural crime and in particular farm theft. They are very keen to come out into the rural communities to talk to various groups i.e. Community Councils, W.I, YFC, Agricultural Groups. REPLACEMENT LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN – 2026 ONWARDS

Work is well underway towards developing the next Local Development Plan. It will take into consideration – population projections, local housing market assessments including the type and location of property needs, housing land supply, completion rates and the economic growth and employment development.

POWYS TEACHING HEALTH BOARD BRIEFING

Applications for the post of Chief Executive Officer for PTHB has just closed on 31.01.2024. Interviews will take place later this month when it is hoped the successful candidate will be announced.

At the briefing, the board has identified the need to move at pace. So a fundamental shift into aged care provision. To strengthen primary and community care and to have a tiered approach to enhance community care. The main areas of acceleration being – frailty and community care, mental health and care planning at an earlier age.

COUNTY FARMS BRIEFING

The Powys County Farms Estate comprises of 8 starter farms (less than 10 acres), 85 intermediate farms (10 – 89 acres) and 42 progression farms (in excess of 90 acres). The estate is currently being re-valued but in 2018/19 is was valued at £95.3m. The annual income is circa £1.2m per annum.

BUDGET SETTING 24/25

The budget was agreed on 22.02.2024 whereby it was set at 7.5% for the next 12 months. The Independent Groups, Conservatives and Plaid Cymru voted against with a total of 32 votes but the Lib Dems/Labour coalition voted for with a total of 34 votes. So hence it was passed.

POWYS SUSTAINABLE FOCUS BRIEFING

There are currently local briefings taking place in the 13 larger towns in Powys to engage with members, schools, town and Community Councils including joint working between Powys County Council, Powys Teaching Health Board, PAVO and Llais. The areas of engagement will be Climate & Nature, Education, Housing, Income & Work, Council & Democracy, Your Community, Infrastructure & Transport and Wellbeing.
