1. **Welcome** - The chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. **Apologies** - None
3. **Declaration of Interest** - Chair registered an interest in point 7 Woodview Aberhafesp.
4. **Minutes of previous meeting** had been sent to each councillor prior to this meeting. Proposed Cllr. R Amy, seconded Cllr. A Pryce. All in agreement minutes to be adopted.
5. **Matters arising - Beechcroft** - No Update  
**Land adjoining Lynwood** - Updated with affordable housing scheme details.  
**Cwm Farm Extension Poultry Unit** - Approved - RESOLVED  
**Rhyd Lydan Mill Aberhafesp LBC & Full** - Application withdrawn - RESOLVED  
**Potholes** - Gilfach, Tyn y Pales and Point Pitch. Job ticket has been raised but there are currently 82 roads in need of repair.
6. **Financial Update** - Total in accounts £3000.25. Bank reconciliation shows no debits or credits outstanding. Clerk will also make an appointment over next few weeks to find out more details on trust funds.
7. **Planning - Woodview Aberhafesp 19/0797/FUL - Installation of ground mounted solar photovoltaic array.** After discussion it was decided that it was small and not visual. The council have no objections to this planning application. Proposed by Cllr. A Pryce, seconded by Cllr R Jones. All in agreement.
8. **Road signs Aberhafesp/Aberhafesb** - Chair stated that we as a Community Council need to give our official opinion on whether any new road signs should be spelt with a P as it is now or with a B. The general consensus of the councillors and that of the community was that the signs should remain with a P. Clerk to inform Chris Lloyd Highways PCC. Proposed by Cllr J Hopkins, seconded by Cllr. A Pryce, all in agreement.
9. **Correspondence** - Advance notification or temporary road closure 16<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> October 2019, from Bethel crossroads to the junction by The College. Road C2158. Residents will be notified. Urdd Eisteddfod asking for councillors to take part in committees. Clerk to write back stating that if they were to contact us again nearer the time that we could possibly help out with stewarding. Email from Mr Clive Pinney, with regards to complaint of agenda not on noticeboard in correct timeframe and minutes not appearing on website until after another meeting has taken place. Clerk

had written back with dates the agenda was placed on noticeboard, and has asked which noticeboard. Also stating that it was the correct procedure to publish the minutes of the meeting after the next meeting, as the minutes had to be approved by the Council before they could be published. Clerk had hoped for a response by this meeting but that had not been possible.

**11. Other Issues** - Pot holes Squilfa Lane, Banc y Wern

Chair noted that it was the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the opening of the Community Centre, there was a celebration on 21<sup>st</sup> July. Tickets were available.
