

## Annual Report 2022 – 2023

There have been 7 Council meetings this year, during these meetings 4 planning applications were discussed. 15 minutes at the beginning of each meeting was now for residents to ask questions or to comment on anything on the agenda, so they did not need to stay for the full meeting if they did not want to, so far nobody had made any comments.

The Council have agreed to fund the Aberhafesp newsletter if needed. A donation was made to the Community Association of £100 towards the costs of the Jubilee celebrations, as well as £250 to support the Community Centre.

The £30,000 from the sale of the quaiting bed has now been invested into a property fund with a company called CCLA.

This year the Council took out a loan with Robert Owen Fund in Newtown to help with the purchase of a Speed Indicator Device (SID) for Aberhafesp village. The SID is moved between 3 locations within the village on a monthly basis.

Potholes continue to be concern within the area
