1. Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. Apologies – Cllr J Hopkins
3. Declaration of Interest - None
4. Members of the public speaking session – None present
5. Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as a true record and signed by the chair.
6. Matter arising – Wern To, Barns at Gethin Waen and Land South of Bwlch y Ffridd all pending consideration.
7. Financial Update
  - 1) Bank Reconciliation – Bank £8532.41, CCLA - £3983.94 – last dividend received £295.61. October 2027 will be 5 years since opening the CCLA account. Will need to decided then what half of the money in the Dividend account will be spent on, within the parish. Members of the public will be invited to attend a meeting to make a decision on this.
  - 2) Employers National Insurance payments. Clerk had paid £113.74 to HMRC for Employers NI. The threshold has decreased to £5000 per year or £417 per month, anyone paid over this triggers Employers NI to be paid. Clerk is paid £600.50 quarterly which is not over £5000! Clerk has spoken to an accountant that has advised to pay monthly, this will then not trigger the Employers NI as it is under £417 a month. Clerk to draw up a payment schedule for the next meeting to be signed by the chair.
  - 3) Payments to Councillors, forms were given out to the councillors to fill in either way if they wanted to receive the payments/allowances of not. There was a brief discussion of what payments/allowances were available.

8. Highways/Road Issues - C Cllr Yeomans was driving around Rhiwcynon Ward on Friday with a member of PCC to look at the issues around the area. A few issues were brought up mainly to do with the state of the roads/potholes in the area.
