FUEL POVERTY INITIATIVE

Muirhall Energy has launched a trial initiative to alleviate fuel poverty in the community council areas of Creich, Ardgay and District, Lairg, Assynt and Lochbroom.

For those who are affected by fuel poverty, a contribution of £20 per household per month towards the cost of buying logs is available. For those who cannot burn logs they are offering match funding towards the cost of home insulation improvements up to a maximum contribution of £250.

This initiative is in response to suggestions from community groups and local residents which was received through meetings for the Muirhall Energy planned wind farm at Caplich by Oykel Bridge.

The log fuel and home insulation support scheme is intended as a trial for potential community benefit initiatives once the wind farm becomes operational. This trial offer will run from now until 31st March 2015.


