## Capital Works Programme – 2023/24

#### **Progress Report**

#### Carriageway resurfacing:

- 2 schemes in Roslin, both on Penicuik Road have been completed. Both schemes are Joint Priority.
- A further 2 schemes in the West area are currently out to Mini-Competition tender.

#### Footway resurfacing:

- 2 schemes in the East area are out to Mini-Competition tender (Dewarton to Cranston crossroads, and Bevan Road, Mayfield). Both schemes are Joint Priority.

As in previous annual programmes, the number of schemes completed will be dependent on available resources, changes to budgets, favourable weather conditions, and any unforeseen events or priorities that could impact on delivery of the programme.

In addition, it has been decided that a portion of the Capital Works Budget will be allocated this year towards the operation of the Pot Hole Pro (PHP) to undertake patch repairs on the public road network. Accordingly, some of the programmed schemes may have to be postponed as there is no additional funding available for the Capital Works Programme. Those schemes affected will be carried forward to next year's programme, or alternatively, may be selectively treated by the PHP to improve their longevity.

The current status of the schemes in the programme can be seen in the table below.

### **Costerton Road Resurfacing**

A query was raised after the last meeting regarding the allocation of Costerton Road as a Joint Priority scheme. On checking back through correspondence, this was found to be in error, and the programme has been amended accordingly.

A request was received from Council for Costerton Road to be included in the programme following previous resurfacing work undertaken in March 2022. On that occasion, the section treated was from the A68 to Fala Dam Road. An assessment was carried out of the rest of the road, and some sections identified for attention in this year's programme, specifically between Fala Dam Road and Salters Road.
