- 1. DW (Chair) welcomed all present and noted the apologies
- 2. Minutes of previous AGM of 11th Oct. 2023
 - These were adopted as a true record (Prop. DJ, Sec. UM)
- 3. Report by the Directors on activities of the company since the AGM
 - AC presented a <u>written report</u> and a slide show of activities over the past year, noting the input by volunteers in the range of activities (dementia, schools, events, woodland management etc) and the wide range of groups making good use of the woods.
 - DW presented an illustrated talk on the previously adopted <u>core principles</u> of the wood and how they serve to guide us in managing the community wood.
