Glasgow Members have the opportunity to **Pay In Advance** (**PI**A) with a reduction for a block of 10 classes This is £54 per block of 10 Classes and this must be paid:

before: 5th Sep 2023 for Autumn Classes (Sept-Nov) and also 5th Jan 2024 for Classes in the New Year (Jan-Mar)

NB For the **New Year (Jan-Mar)** the Beginners have a block of 11 classes with a **Pay In Advance (PIA)** price of £60 before 5 Jan 2024

Please use the **correct reference** for **PIA** when paying by Bank Transfer (our preferred method). Ref: code (see below) + your name (or enough of your name as to identify you).

Paying for individual classes, or less than the entire block, please use the **code** listed with each class on the website.

Visitors:

We welcome visitors to our classes and whilst the first class is free for all who have not Scottish country danced before, visitors will be charged £8 per class attended.

If, however, they are members of another RSCDS Branch_(or a RSCDS Society only member) then the following applies:

- A visitor to the area who is a RSCDS Member but who is not a member of Glasgow Branch may visit a class up to **twice in a block of 10 classes** and pay the Glasgow Member's class fee.
- If they wish to dance a 3rd time, or more, they must pay the Associate Membership fee to be able to pay the Member's class fee for each of the rest of the classes they attend that block, otherwise they pay Non-Member's class fee for each of the rest of the classes they attend.

Note: paying Associate Membership fee also means you can then pay Member's class fee for any Glasgow Branch classes attended in the rest of the Membership Year (1 July 2023 – 30 June 2024).
