Minutes of Parish Council Meeting 7:30pm, 14 February 2022, North Frodingham Social Centre.

1. Apologies for Absence

Councillors C. Dewhirst, Mrs J. Evison and Mrs A. Greaves apologised for their absences.

2. Approval of Meeting Minutes for 10 January 2022

The minutes were approved.

4. Ward Councillor's Update

There were no ward councillors present at the meeting.

5. Matters Arising

The Parish Council adopted the East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC) Town and Parish Council Charter.

6. Administration

To receive updates on:

a. Village Improvement Committee

Funding for the noticeboards has been received and they will soon be delivered and installed in the Cemetery. The Millstone marker for the entrance to the village is complete and work has started on the base, hopefully it will be ready for installation for Easter. The new lawn mower has been purchased and the Parish Council approved the sale of the old lawn mower for £400.

b. Social Centre

Investigations are continuing into internet connection providers and organisers are looking into online booking systems for the hall. The Post Office are surveying the hall to see if it is suitable to use as an occasional pop-up post office. The next big event will be the Frod Prod on St George's Day (23 April 2022). The application to the Jubilee Community Fund was successful and there will be a party during the Jubilee Weekend.

c. Allotments

The Parish Council is looking at securing funding for the work needed on the garden/allotments and a quote for tree works has been received and an alternative quote is being sought. The Clerk will investigate liability and insurance conditions of allotments.

d. Village Matters

East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC) stated that the footpaths from Grange Road to the Playing Field and from Cross Lane to the Cemetery meet their basic standards and no repairs will be carried out.
