Interment in the Cemetery is reserved for residents of North Frodingham and those who can prove they previously lived in the village and their close families. The above fees are **doubled** if the deceased person was no longer a resident of North Frodingham. An exception is made if the deceased moved from North Frodingham to a Residential/Nursing home.

The Parish Council reserves the right to change fees at any time. Fees are exclusive of grave digging and fees payable to a Minister of Religion Any fees not listed above will be equal to the current charges for East Riding of Yorkshire Council cemetery charges <u>www.eastriding.gov.uk/living/deaths/cemeteries</u> Plots will be allocated in order of rotation.

## Memorials:

- no ledgers, kerbs or edgings are allowed in the cemetery and the maximum height of a memorial stone is 4 feet (120cm).
- All vertical memorials must conform to the National Association of Memorial Mason (NAMM) ground support fixing system or an alternative approved by NAMM.
- A memorial placed over cremated remains is restricted to a flat 18" square tablet flush with the surrounding lawn.
