1. Apologies for Absence

Councillor Mrs J. Syers and Ward Councillor J. Evison apologised for absences.

2. Approval of Meeting Minutes 14 June 2021

The minutes were approved.

3. Declaration of Interests

There were no declarations of interest.

4. Ward Councillors Update

Ward Councillors were not present at the meeting but will be contacted to ask if the Social Centre can use the railings outside the building to display advertising banners. The railings are the property of East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

5. Matters Arising

a. Humberside Police & Crime Commissioner Survey

The Parish Council was asked to raise awareness of a survey by the Humberside Police & Crime Commissioner that ran until 11 July 2021. A notice was placed on the Parish Council website.

b. National Highways and Transport Survey

A survey was completed at the request of East Riding of Yorkshire Council asking opinions on services provided regarding condition of roads, footpaths and cycling facilities.

c. B1249 Wansford to North Frodingham

East Riding of Yorkshire Council proposed to reduce the speed limit on the B1249 between Wansford and North Frodingham to 50 miles per hour.

Resolved: The Parish Council approved the proposal.

6. Administration

To receive updates on:

a. Village Improvement Committee

- There are now eight volunteers for Community Speedwatch and Councillor Silcock is working towards getting the project underway.
- The Committee is looking at methods of obtaining funding for village improvements and the possibility of a leaflet drop and/or a walk about to receive ideas from residents later in the year when hopefully COVID cases are lower.
- The Parish Council is still waiting for a date for the traffic survey along the main street.
- Councillors will be attending the Social Centre Summer Fayre and will be able to answer any questions or listen to ideas from residents.
- Lisset Windfarm have offered a grant of £4000, £8200 was applied for. It was hoped the grant would allow for the purchase of a new mower, railings and gate repair for the cemetery. Councillors are seeking updated quotes and the cost of hiring a mower to enable an informed decision on the best way to use the grant.
- Councillors are looking into the cost and suitable location for a mill stone to be placed at the entrance to the village.
