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Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting, 7:30pm on 14 July 2025, in the Village Hall.

Present: Councillors: Chair T Walker, Vice-chair J Syers, M Doyle, R Richardson, D Stead, N Walker and S Watson. Ward Councillors J Bibb and D Howard and Clerk M Rose.
Absent: Councillors: A Greaves and S Watson.

Public Participation. No items were raised.

1. Apologies for Absence

There were no apologies.

2. Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the meeting on 9 June 2025 were approved.

3. Declaration of Interests

Councillors N Walker and T Walker declared interests in matters relating to the Village Hall.

4. Matters for Ward Councillors

East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC) will be writing a letter to the Government objecting to the proposed changes to the National Planning Policy, it believes the proposals if passed will have a substantial impact on local authorities, and there will be less chance for local voices to be heard.

5. Matters Arising and Correspondence

- a. **Cross Lane Traffic Survey.** The Traffic Management Team at ERYC shared the results of a recent traffic survey on Cross Lane. The results state the speed limit on the road is 60mph, average speed of vehicles is 38mph with 85% of vehicles travelling at 44mph. The team has stated that given the low speeds and recently improved road conditions, no further intervention is required, although the Road Safety team will continue to closely monitor the site to ensure any emerging issues are addressed promptly. Councillors discussed the results and ERYC will be contacted as Cross Lane has a 30mph limit, not a 60mph limit.
- b. **Village Hall Committee Thank you.** The Chairman sent thanks to the Parish Council for granting and administering the recent fund which helped towards the celebrations for the VE Day 80th anniversary.
- c. **Freedom of Information Publication Scheme.** The Parish Council adopted the draft scheme.

6. Administration.

- a. **Village Improvement Working Group.** A discussion was held on ways to improve the village although funding is restricted. ERYC will be contacted for an update on the project to improve the footpath on Church Lane. A flag and decorations will be placed in the Millennium Garden to mark the 80th anniversary of VJ Day.
- b. **Village Hall.** Councillor N Walker has been appointed Treasurer for the Village Hall and Councillor T Walker has been appointed Assistant Treasurer. The Hall has been awarded an alcohol licence in principle. There will be a Table Top Sale on the 9th August.

- c. **Millennium Garden Wall.** The Parish Council approved the addition of the small wall at the front of the garden and the feature wall around the pump to be added to the Parish Council insurance.

7. Planning

- a. **Notification of Appeal.** 24/001107/REFUSE Coney Garth Hill, Brandesburton Road. Change of use of land to permit the siting of a glamping pod following the removal of existing static caravan (resubmission of 22/01004/PLF). The Parish Council had no objections to this application.
- b. **Local Plan Notice of Adoption.** ERYC adopted the Providing Open Space on New Housing Developments Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). The adopted SPD provides further guidance on the provision of open space as part of new developments.
