Meeting at Bainton on Remembrance Sunday, we gathered in time to observe the two-minute silence and then twelve of us set off on this old favourite. Following the lane past the church to Neswick, then right at the junction we were soon into open countryside with wide views all around. A slight incline to "Brackenberg" bridge and we were over the site of the old railway line to Middleton. Continuing up the lane to the Burn Butts junction, the senior contingent (including Bob at 93!) left us





to take the green lane short cut back to Bainton. The rest of us took the left turn to Burn Butts to pick up the footpath leading down to Cawkeld, finding a lunch spot en route. 


