Platinum Jubilee

In January ERYC had a grant scheme offering up to £500 to help communities with their plans to celebrate the jubilee, the scheme was a great success & over 130 parishes came forward to access the funding.

Commonwealth Games

Birmingham is to host the Commonwealth Games with the opening ceremony on 28th July this year.

As part of the build-up to the event, there is already underway a Baton Relay, the journey of the Baton brings together & celebrates communities in every part of the commonwealth ahead of the opening in Birmingham.

ERYC made a bid to have the Baton visit our area & has been selected as one of 180 successful communities to be listed.

The Baton will arrive in Beverley on the morning of 13th July and then on to Market Weighton.

One of our confirmed baton bearers is Luke Lambert from Beverley who has been chosen because of his contribution to his local community.

Area of Natural Beauty (AONB)

The Yorkshire Wolds have been put forward to Natural England to be considered as an AONB.

Natural England is now asking for opinions on the landscapes and heritage of the Yorkshire Wolds as they assess its potential for designation.

They are inviting as many people as possible to get involved, whether you run a local business, represent a local organisation, or just have an interest they are asking for your input.

The first drop-in sessions started on the 9th & 10th of June but more are planned for the 21st, 22nd & 23rd of June at venues to be confirmed on the website. Or you can share your views by visiting the newly launched website <https://www.yorkshire-wolds-designation-project.org>

History Group report

On Sunday 5th June members of the History Group opened the Chapel within the Cemetery. We had 40 people come to see the exhibitions and photographs and due to the interest, we hope to open the Chapel again every Sunday during August.


To mark the Queen's Jubilee, we had a tea party instead of the usual tea and biscuits.
