May is the time for one of our favourite walks. We made our way to Pockley near Helmsley for the annual display of bluebells. Following Intake Lane we headed up into the woods through a carpet of Spring flowers which also included anemones, stitchwort and violets. We then dropped down into Riccal Dale which was swathed in a sea of bluebells. A stiff climb past Hasty Bank Farm brought us through dense woodland with a floor of wild garlic before coming out into the open with spectacular views towards Pockley Moor. A grand day out!



For the June outing, we stayed much closer to home for a leisurely stroll along the banks of the beck between Watton and Kilnwick. On a scorching hot day ten of us met near the Abbey and, after a sprint across the busy main road, took the path out of Watton and through the colourful front garden of Mill Cottage to follow Watton Beck. Entering the woods, we found Kilnwick Beck which led us through to the village.

A brief detour to look around the churchyard and then through the park with its eye-catching flower meadow and onto the lane to Cawkeld. Staying on the lane past the whimsically named Wedding Wood and with lunch on our mind, we turned through the wood and its impressive lake in the Cawkeld Sinks Plantation to find the ideal spot (left, photo thanks to Ann).
