

Parish Council News

The Parish Council has received several complaints regarding extreme occurrences of horse poo in the village, which has been reported to East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC). Although this is not illegal, many residents think it is unpleasant, and ERYC can be asked to do a clean-up. Residents can report this and any other issues directly to ERYC on the website www.eastriding.gov.uk or by calling customer services on 01482 393939.

Two potential water leaks have been reported to Yorkshire Water, one on South Townside Road on the corner where the road joins the Public Right of Way to Grange Road and one halfway down Mount Pleasant Road. If anyone spots any leaks, they can be reported to Yorkshire Water on 03451 242424.

If anyone is struggling due to the current financial crisis, your local Children's Centre can help you to access a food bank service close to you, the nearest food bank is in Beeford, telephone number 01262 481699. 

EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL NEWS

DO IT FOR EAST YORKSHIRE COMMUNITY FUND

Since June 2021, voluntary and community groups, as well as Town & Parish Councils in East Riding, have been benefiting from the Do it for East Yorkshire Community Grants, which were designed to help communities come together after Covid. Organisations were able to apply for grants between £500 and £5000 that:

- Brought people back into your community
- Focused on encouraging people who have been shielding to engage in community activities
- Restarted community activities, such as lunch clubs
- One-off events & festivals.

The fund closed in April 2022 but subsequently opened again in June 2022 with a further £145,00 to distribute.

HELP FOR HOUSEHOLDS / HELP FOR BUSINESSES

The help for Households campaign was launched through Your East Riding offering online support for urgent help when in need, help with household bills, support for young families with children, support for older people, help with debt and money worries and disability services and adult care.

That campaign has now spread and will shortly also offer Help for Businesses.

There are now clear links to the help pages, which are available from the ERYC website homepage.

FRACKING

In October, we were pleased to support a motion to Full Council agreeing that fracking activities in the East Riding of Yorkshire are inappropriate. Whilst acknowledging the need to review our national need for energy security considering recent events in Russia and Ukraine, our view that fracking is not the way forward remains unchanged. There are still concerns over the effects of fracking on the aquifer under the wolds and the counter effect on our ambitions to have an area of outstanding natural beauty.

We will continue to oppose any suggestion of fracking in this area.



In 1949 a fire completely destroyed Bell Mills and a new modern mill was built and has since been extended and further modernised to the buildings that are there today.

Most of the flour is named after celestial objects for example Venus.

They even produce a Halal flour along with, pizza dough flour and unleaven bread.

An interesting fact is that if all the flour mills stopped producing then after approx 12 hours we would run out of bread!
