8 Update from Local Groups

8.1 Broadband - from Phil Game

We now have 26 live subscribers live, 7 more subscribers are ready to connect pending the delivery of the ADSL line in Lochcarron. We expect to have 66 subscribers in total when the project is complete. Our monthly usage is averaging 250 GB. There were no problems apart from power cuts.

The tariff for year 2 has been set at; 10GB - £10, 20GB - £19, 30GB - £28, 40GB - £37 per month which is approximately 30% discount on year 1.

Progress by location:-

- **Lochcarron** The power has been connected, the link to Creag Mhaol is active and showing good signal strength and a good quality connection. Openreach visited on the 6th October to install the new ADSL line but did not connect the telephone line as they should have sent their surveyor first. Zen (our ISP) has made a new application through Openreach and we are waiting for a new installation date.
- **The Glen -** Both relays have been erected and the power supply installed by the Hydro, the meter should be installed early in November and our electrician can then connect our consumer unit. The system is expected to be operational in November but it is dependent on the Lochcarron ADSL line.

- **Craig -** We have installed the relay and have a temporary power supply available, this installation is now dependant on finalising the location of the Ardaneaskan relay.
- **Ardaneaskan -** We have tested a link to Craig and have decided to purchase radios that are slightly more powerful than our normal Nanostations to cover the longer distances. One resident has been connected via a temporary link direct to Creag Mhaol to test the range of the new dishes (NanoBeam CPE). This link has good signal strength but is showing poor quality. Speeds are fine for one subscriber but will need further investigation if the link were to be used for multiple subscribers. We have yet to finalise the location of the relay.
- **Portchullin** The relay to serve Ardaneaskan East and North Strome has been erected. We now have the signed lease agreement from the Forestry and have applied for the power connection from SSE and are waiting for an installation date.

Strome Ferry - We have started work looking for a suitable site for a relay to link Lochcarron and North Strome.

There was an open meeting in September which was poorly attended by existing subscribers.

The West Coast backbone project has ordered the 1,000 Mbps leased line in Mallaig which is expected to be delivered in November. Testing has started on high speed radio links to bring the service north, initially as far as Applecross.

- Work continues on the Whole Farm Review which will result in an Action Plan to help the Trust determine priorities for the coming years
