# 3.1 Bandwidth

# 5.1 Next year's tariff

The total number of gigabytes sold was 7,550. The break even tariff for 2 fibre lines is 74 GB per £1, and for 3 fibre lines is 49 GB per £1.

Prior to the meeting Phil circulated figures showing income projected for the next financial year. The standing charge will remain the same at £5 to cover fixed costs. Our financial objective is to make a surplus contingency of  $\sim$  £1,000.

It is expected that the number of subscribers will increase significantly from 44 to over 70 in the next year and this will require additional capacity. Assuming one additional landline and new subscribers will have similar usage to existing subscribers the following figures were calculated:-

At £1per 50 GB we will make a £1,000 surplus with 54 subscribers

At £1per 75 GB we will make a £1,000 surplus with 62 subscribers

At £1per 100 GB we will make a £1,000 surplus with 75 subscribers

None of the figures above take into account any other income - e.g. from the New Joiner's Premium or growth from increased usage of existing subscribers..

It is clear that there is scope for a further reduction in the tariff in year six. However the timing of some events e.g. the installation of the additional capacity to coincide with demand from new subscribers might prove to be very difficult to manage. It was therefore decided that the year six rate reduction will be implemented by a subscription refund at the end of the financial year.

Therefore in July / August 2020 there will be a review of the financial position and at the director's discretion subscribers will be granted a subscription refund and / or a reduction in the New Joiner's Premium.

# 7 Customer Relations

### 7.1 Production Environment

# 7.1.1 Problems and complaints

During this month the system has suffered several incidents of False Radar contacts. These have affected mainly Braeintra. It is not fully understood why this is happening as the latest up- grades to the firmware were supposed to prevent this from occurring. The firmware was reverted to an earlier version but the problem persisted. It was then decided to change the access point from a NanoStation to a NanoBeam and this appears to have reduced the problem. Monitoring continues.

The monthly total for August was 3.6 TB this is the highest ever recorded. The daily average was 116.2 GB; with a peak usage of 195.2 GB on Monday 5<sup>th</sup>, again the highest daily usage ever recorded.

Four customers exceeded their quota for the month and have had their quotas increased.
