

CMNet PRODUCTION ENVIRONMENT FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF OPERATION

CMNet has now been online for almost one year. The system has proven itself to be remarkable robust over this period, and all major outages have been due to power cuts and problems with other outside agencies (BT and Managed Communications). There have been minor defects with power supplies and AirRouters but they have been rapidly identified and rectified leading to minimal downtime. Some customers have had problems with leads becoming disconnected or wrongly connected and again these were quickly identified and put right.

The table below shows monthly usage and the daily averages. It can be quite clearly seen that the system is now being more heavily used as people have become to realise that they can now do so much more than they could when using BT.

We currently have 25 subscribers on two lines from the Plockton exchange and with a possible 29 more customers waiting for a connection we are going to more than double our capacity over the coming months. We are probably looking at having to procure three more lines either all from Lochcarron or split between Lochcarron and Plockton.

With the figures produced by Hamish it looks as though we may be able to reduce the tariff next year possibly by up to 30%.
