

Correction to the Minutes of the Parish Meeting held on 1st November 2017

Following circulation of the minutes, Councillor Richard Ormston, Ward Member for Lower Wensleydale, issued the following correction, clarifying the item on ward boundaries which was discussed under 'Any other business' at the meeting:

In the minutes of last week's parish meeting it was stated that the new Ward boundaries were coming into effect. What is actually happening is a public consultation is now happening in Richmondshire up until the 15th of January 2018 where the public can comment on the Draft recommendation on the new electoral arrangements for Richmondshire District Council. The Local Government Boundary Commission for England published their draft recommendation for Richmondshire last week in which they suggested that Thornton Steward would remain in the Lower Wensleydale Ward.
