The above prices are subject to VAT (20%) and include the removal of all debris arising from the work which will be returned to our depot for recycling.

Items on this quote can be undertaken individually, however we operate at a minimum charge of £555.00 per visit. This cost will be incurred if the items total less than this.

This is a fixed price quotation and is valid for six months unless otherwise agreed.

All tree work is to be undertaken in accordance with current good arboricultural practice and guidance.

If any additional work is required, please refer to our Terms & Conditions – Price & Quotations, this is available on request.

As part of our procedure, we would check with the Local Authority if the trees concerned are situated within a Conservation Area or are covered by a Tree Preservation Order. We can submit an application on your behalf if required as part of our service.

There is no charge for this service unless it is necessary to purchase an Ordnance Survey Map from the Local Authority (please note that the council will not accept a Google Earth Map or image).

Please note: We cannot guarantee that any application that we submit will be approved by the local planning authority.

If authorisation has already been obtained, please inform our office, and send a copy of the council's decision notice detailing what work that has been agreed prior to any work commencing.

If the trees are located near to overhead service cables an electrical shut down or shrouding maybe required to enable us to carry out the work. We can apply for this service on your behalf but there may be an additional charge for this service which has not been include in our quotation. We will contact you directly to discuss this if any additional cost is to be occurred.

The wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 states that it is a criminal offence to intentional damage or destroy a bird's nest (active or inactive) during nesting season. If nests are found work will be suspended and then re-booked back in between September and March. This is outside of bird nesting season and then every effort will then be made to complete the work (active nest dependant). It is not always possible for nest to be detected during pricing.
