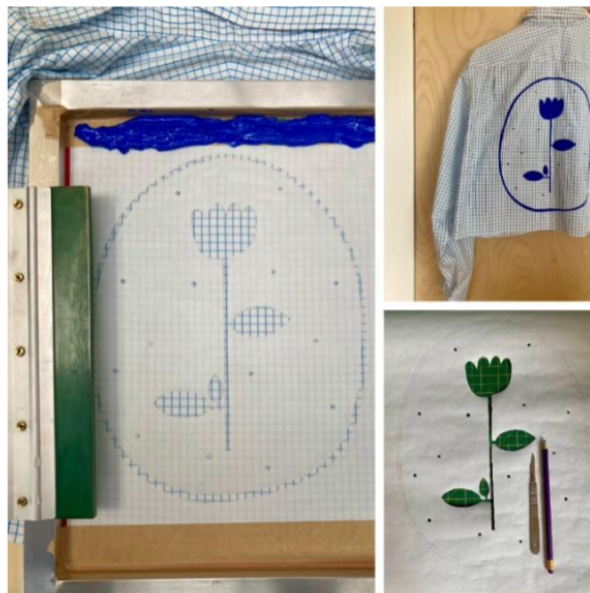
18-19 July 2026, 10am – 4pm



Forget fast fashion - join **Colleen Coe** from Timber + Stitch and transform your own clothing with sewing and screen printing. Take home a unique, customised garment!

The course will involve:

- Introduction to screen printing
- Drawing and cutting a paper stencil
- Screen printing onto your garment
- Adjusting your garment with sewing machine
- Learning about different fabrics
- Garment construction and clothing patterns



Saturday

Draw your ideas onto paper discussing the best ways to adapt them for screen printing. Cut out your stencils, prepare your screen for printing and print straight onto your garment. You can use multiple stencils to add colours.

Sunday

Sewing. Adjust your garment using different techniques or combine several bits of clothing together. Learn about garment construction and fabrics. Sew your screen printed details to your garment to make a completely unique, made-by-you creation.



This course is suitable for beginners although good if you can use a sewing machine. The only requirement is that you enjoy being creative!

Colleen Coe has been screen printing for over nine years and sewing for as long as she can remember. She is a Design graduate who has products stocked in independent shops and teaches adults and kids from her studio space in Aviemore.
