How to get to Killearnan Church Hall from Inverness: (over for map)

- 1. Drive to Tore Roundabout and take first left (towards Beauly/Muir of Ord)
- 2. Continue for approx 1.5-2 miles
- 3. At "The Spud Hut" (on right), turn left into a single track road
- 4. Follow single track road (doubling back on yourself, also a few potholes) for approx 3/4mile
- 5. Hall is on the left, with parking. (Church is on the right)

What should I bring?

Pastels and Paper will be provided for the first 2 weeks of your course after which you will be given advice on what to buy/bring along, but always bring the following:

- 1. Pastels are very messy so bring a protective cover for your table and for the floor!
- 2. A drawing board (38cm x 50cm is a good size)
- 3. Masking tape (25mm is fine)
- 4. Hairspray or pastel fixative
- 5. Sketchbook, pencils and rubber
- 6. Craft knife
- 7. Surgical gloves (optional pastels can be 'hard on your hands')
- 8. Old bristle art brush (to remove mistakes)
- 9. Wet wipes
- 10. Photos or still life to work from

What should I wear?

Wear old clothes or an apron
