- 1. Welcome Peter Hall the Chairman welcomed 46 members and 6 members of the public

- **3.** <u>Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> AGM</u> Minutes of 4th AGM on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2015 were adopted proposed by Tim Finnegan and seconded by Pat Carroll.
- **4. Matters Arising** There were no matters arising.
- **5.** Chairman's Report The Chairman, Peter Hall delivered his report for the year 2015-2016. The Board had met monthly and were pleased that the title of the land previously owned by Novar Estates had been transferred to The Findhorn Village Conservation Company on 3rd March 2016. Directors had attended seminars and visited other community groups. The Company has received stage 1 lottery funding of £14,750 to investigate the possibilities for the Garage site on Seaforth Lane. The next step is to secure funding to purchase the site. A bequest has been received from the late David Urquhart of £50.707 k with the proviso that it be used to facilitate a path from the Piers to a viewpoint on the Moray Firth.
