88 19/20	<p>Kettering Borough Council Conservation Policy: Brampton Ash</p> <p>Cllr Lillie had approached Simon Richardson, Development Manager – Planning Policy, at Kettering Borough Council (KBC) in October 2019 to voice his concern that, in its current form, the KBC Conservation Area Appraisal for the village appeared to offer little protection from inappropriate development. Furthermore, it had been adopted in September 1992: it did not comply with Historic England's guidelines and subsequent changes to planning legislation in recent decades appeared to remove some of the protection previously afforded to the village. This was referenced by the Planning Inspectorate's response to Planning Application KET/2018/0683 when allowing an appeal against KBC's refusal of the application. In his response dated 21 January 2020, Simon Richardson acknowledged that there is a need to review many of the KBC Conservation Areas, resources permitting. He stated that current planning policies designate Brampton Ash a 'scattered village' and emerging policies intend to re-designate it a Category C village. Due to the scattered nature of the village, its size and its limited facilities, the emerging Local Plan is not allocating land for development at Brampton Ash and will only allow development in exceptional circumstances where specific criteria are met in relation to size, form, character and setting in the village, amongst other criteria ('other criteria' was not specified).</p>
