

Finances

This October we received our regular annual donation of £1,000 from the Ross McArthur's scheme and as we expected, the small income from the Amazon Smile scheme has now come to an end. Beginning in November, we are now receiving a £40 increase (taking us to £90 per month) for Stuart's Technical Support provided to Hydrover and JB Hydro.

The fund level at End-'23 stands at £23,649.33 of which £2000 is already committed to projects. A further £7,000 of the fund is currently ring fenced as an 'Emergency Fund' leaving a balance of £14,649.33 available to be used for new projects until we receive further income in the first half of 2024.

The Trustees would like to emphasise that our role is to hold the funds securely and to assign them to worthwhile causes that comply with the ART constitution. These funds belong to the ART Members and the Trustees really need the Members to bring forward ideas for projects at can benefit from this resource. So if you have an idea for something that will enhance the village or local environment then we'd love to hear from you even if it's just a casual initial enquiry.

ART Banking Changes

In order to provide a more up-to-date service and to obtain interest on the funds being held, ART have moved their banking services to CAF Bank. This bank (Charities Aid Foundation) is aimed at organisations such as ours. So we now have 2 accounts a Cash Account and Gold Account, the latter already providing the interest and holds most of the fund. This move now gives us the ability to manage the funds online and provide direct payments to applicant's bank accounts.

Annual Submission to OSCR

We have completed our annual submission of accounts to the Scottish Charity Regulator (OSCR). This covers the financial year 22-23.

Picnic Tables

Applicant – Neil Robinson

£1569.42 part funded by ART

The 2 picnic tables, now located on the shore by the slip, were purchased with funds from ART, the Ardentinny Centre and the Community Council. These provide an alternative gathering point to the beach area which has become much busier since lockdown. Ownership of the benches has been transferred to the Village Hall.



Carpark Toilets Cleaning Contract

Applicant – Ardentinny CC

£1242 part funded by ART

This payment supplements the funding from A&B Council to cover the annual cost of weekly cleaning which is required in order for the toilets to remain open to the public.



Village Hall Blinds

Applicant – Village Hall

£400 part funded by ART

Following the repair to the guttering which was delaying further improvements, new blinds have now been purchased and installed in the Village Hall.
