
Anyone living in the Ardentinny Community Council area is eligible to become a member of the Trust (some restrictions may apply)


REVENUE INCOME FROM COMMENCEMENT UP TO MID-2021

A little additional revenue is now arriving from Amazon Smile. This is a scheme whereby Amazon shoppers can select a charity of their choice and Amazon will give 0.5% percent of the purchase price to the nominated charity at no extra cost to the purchaser. A further source of monthly income has been secured from Hydrover of £16.66 monthly for technical support for their schemes in Ardentinny and Innellan. As Hydrover are not based in Scotland, this support (handled by Stuart and Dougie) covers providing them with local "eyes on" feedback, fault finding and minor intervention such as rebooting the equipment after a power cut.

An additional payment of £200 was made to us for a more involved job of diagnosing that there was a break in one of the buried sensor cables in the Finart scheme caused by forestry operations on the road by the pipeline. This fault prevented half of the Finart system generating any electricity. Diagnosing there was a break and its approximate location allowed Hydrover to attend fully prepared for the repair and have it quickly fixed with a morning's work.

We have been advised that JB Hydro is interested in a similar support arrangement for the Cuil and Schoolhouse systems.

PROJECTS WE APPROVED FOR FUNDING IN THE FIRST HALF OF 2021

Village Carpark Toilet Cleaning

The £600 funding will kick-start the event covering the costs of the porta loos, tea/coffee soft drinks for all 3 venues, marketing such as ads and flyers and any other incidentals.

All money raised throughout the day including any money left over from the £600 will be counted as a single pot and split between the 3 venues equally.

THE HYDRO SCHEMES UPDATE

All four schemes are now operational.

Scheme 1 – Glen Finart (operated by Hydrover)

Scheme 2 - Drynain Burn (operated by Ross MacArthur)

Scheme 3 – Cuil Burn (operated by JB Hydro)

Scheme 4 – Schoolhouse Burn (operated by JB Hydro)

Commissioned in February, the Ardentinny Outdoor Centre now has the benefit of discounted electricity from this scheme. Whilst income for the Trust is being generated, we may not see our first payment until 2022.
