


REVENUE INCOME FROM COMMENCEMENT UP TO MID 2023

This half year saw annual payments of just over £20,000 in total from the Finart, Cuil and Schoolhouse schemes. These payments were higher than normal due to the better feed-in tariff these companies were receiving for which we receive a fixed 5% of the generated revenue. May saw what we believe to be the final payment from the Amazon Smile scheme which has now come to an end. We continue to receive £50 per month for Technical Support provided to Hydrover and JB Hydro by Stuart. This support involves web based monitoring of the equipment in the turbine houses and fault finding and repairing as and when there is a problem. Minimising any equipment downtime ensures we maximise our revenue from the schemes.

The fund level at Mid-'23 stands at £25,795.26 of which up to £2342 is already committed to projects. A further £6,000 of the fund is currently ring fenced as an 'Emergency Fund' leaving a balance of around £17,458 available to be used for new projects until we receive further income over the coming months which is expected to be about £1,300 by the year end.

PROJECTS WE HAVE FUNDED IN THE FIRST HALF OF 2023

Projector, Ukuleles and Tuners

Applicant – Ardentinny Music Group

£249.02 fully funded by ART

2 ukuleles, tuners and a projector for use by the members in the group. The projector will be kept at the hall and will be available for other groups to use.



Defibrillator Maintenance

Applicant – Ardentinny CC

£354 fully funded by ART

The defibrillator unit at the slip required the charge pack replaced as it was approaching its use by date. In addition extra pads were purchased as future supply was at risk due to the unit becoming obsolete.





Sit-on Mower

Applicant – Walled Garden £2000 part funded by ART

The Walled Garden purchased a brand new sit-on mower which is better suited to the size of the garden and the operators. This was a local purchase and which ensures that servicing will be available.



Gazebos and Gas BBQs

Applicant – Ardentinny Village Hall £1794.94 fully funded by ART





Two gas BBQs and 2 Gazebos have been purchased by the Village Hall for use at outdoor events. These are also being made available for villagers to borrow on a donation basis.
