### Ardentinnny Community Council News

#### Information for Dog Walkers

Wild Radish has been found sporadically along the coast path/shoreline from Coronation Wood down towards the River Finart.

We contacted Bute and Cowal Vets, and they confirmed that Wild radish can cause nasty stomach upsets in dogs.

This is different to the Hemlock Water dropwort (poisonous parsnip) which can be found around Ardentinnny and this whole plant is extremely poisonous, those are the ones on the signs that Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) put up last year along the path.

I have attached a picture of both plants at the end of the email.

The advice from Bute and Cowal Vets is against letting dogs chew on any wild plants along the shore and waterways.



#### Potholes
