Hi All.

In light of the risk from Storm Eowyn (rated as a Red risk to life alert now) as it comes through tomorrow (Friday) here is the weekly news from the Ardentinny Community Council and the Village Hall.

Preparation for Storm Eowyn

Here a few reminders of the recommended precautions you can take for the high winds that are expected;

Heavy Winds

- Secure loose objects such as ladders and garden furniture, wheelie bins to avoid unnecessary spillage of rubbish
- oClose and securely fasten doors and windows, including garages
- oPark vehicles in a garage or in a place clear of buildings, trees and fences
- Stay indoors if possible
- olf you need to go outside, do not walk or shelter close to buildings or trees
- o Don't carry out repairs whilst the storm is in progress
- oDo not drive unless your journey is essential and avoid exposed routes
- o Do not touch electric/telephone cables which may have been blown down

We are at risk of a power cut and potentially falling trees blocking the road to Dunoon, so make sure you have mobile phones charged up, enough food, water and toiletries.

If we have a power cut you can phone 105 to report it, hopefully the mobile network will keep going.
