Those of you that have been into the hall recently will have noticed that the second phase of heating replacement, comprising new storage heaters in the toilets, kitchen, and store rooms has now been installed and is operational. In addition, we have been fine tuning the high and low temperature settings on the thermostat controlling the radiant panel heaters in the main hall to optimise its effectiveness.
