We are arranging a date for an AGM meeting when we will be looking for members to join the hall management group. We are looking for a new Chairman as after 6 years, Guy is stepping down and although Dee will still be a member of the group, will no longer be secretary while Neil is coming off the group altogether. Without a management group, the hall, according to the constitution, would close and need to be sold. Any money generated by the sale will go to another charity or organisation within the village which will more than likely be the Ardentinny Renewables Trust (ART).

We know you have all enjoyed attending the functions which were organised last year, as these have been requested to happen again on a yearly basis, starting this year. As most of you are aware, Neil and Dee are currently organising and setting up the majority of functions and extra fund raising for the hall. Unfortunately, this is

unsustainable, especially for the larger functions. It would be nice if all groups which currently use the hall could come onto the committee.

Rather than having the obligatory minimum of 3 on the group, it may be better to have several members which means the workload is spread rather than just one or two people doing everything and avoiding the same issue in another few years where people feel obliged to volunteer just to keep the hall open and avoid the same thing happening every few years.

The hall is currently in a very good position financially due to funds raised already and we are looking at funding to install new heating internet connections and some work on the kitchen area is also planned to enable the hall to sell food again.
