A Combined Community Council, Dunoon to Gourock Ferry Service Survey

Proposed Windfarm - Giants Burn, Sandbank

The proposed wind farm is located 2.1km north-west of Dunoon and 1.5km south-west of Sandbank.

A83 Overnight closure 6 May 2024

For your awareness, the A83 will be closed on the night of Monday 6 May (22.00 to 04.00) to allow barrier installation at Glen Kinglas (Butter Bridge), amnesties will be provided at 0000 and 0200. These works involve the installation of a concrete safety barrier which will provide protection to the A83 from landslide material and further enhance safety, resilience, and operation of the A83 Trunk Road.

I have attached a map for the location where it is closed and also the diversion via Inverary, Dalmally, Crianlarich to Tarbet.
