Tree Preservation Orders – Ardentinny

Some of you may have noticed that there is a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) notice on the old gate post at the entry to Coronation Wood. The National Park Planning Office are conducting a review of all Tree Preservation orders in the Park with a view to updating each one in terms of its condition, size or other associated criteria. For Coronation Wood an update is required based on the increased extent of the wood.

We also have another TPO area that covers the Glenfinart Caravan Park. There are also two TPO's in Blairmore that cover specific mature trees (Redwoods, Cypresses, Cedar, Conifer etc) along the Shore Road at Creggandarroch House and Blarachorine.

Hall Management Group Meeting

Please note that from the 1st of April 2024, the hire of the hall is increasing and will be £10 per hour for all groups. As far as we are aware, the prices have not been reviewed in the last 10 years and need to be raised to cover electricity and insurance and reflect changes over the previous years.

Membership Due

Memberships for the next 12-month period for the hall are now once again due for payment.

Previously members of the village have paid throughout the year, and this has created some issues when accounting for the money therefore we have now simplified the process.

The fees are the equivalent of £1 Per calendar month due April -May each year so £12 for the full year per person.
