1. Mariners are advised that an area of Loch Long, bounded by the coordinates below, will be out of bounds to all non-military vessel traffic from 2100 03 May 25 - 0100 04 May 25 in order to protect personnel in the water participating in a military training exercise.

- •North of 56°07.42'N 004°49.21'W.
- South of 56°10.58'N 004°46.49'W.



2. Mariners are requested to keep clear from the vicinity of the event, to mitigate against any adverse interaction with the participants.

HALL AGM IS THIS NEXT TUESDAY -NEW TRUSTEES NEEDED URGENTLY The AGM will be held at 7 30pm on Tuesd

The AGM will be held at 7.30pm on Tuesday 6th May 2025. The hall constitution requires a minimum of 3 Trustees for a quorum, it cannot legally continue with only 1 Trustee remaining. In the event of no new Trustees coming forward *then the hall will be forced to close and the property sold*. Surplus funds would then be transferred to other charitable bodies.



If the hall is lost it is highly unlikely that we would manage to get it replaced. It's a fantastic facility for the village as well as being the emergency hub for the community.

Please, please if you are a regular (or occasional) hall Member or user consider 'standing in the gap' for a season so that we can retain the hall for current and future users.
