Friday 15th November 13.00-16.00 and Saturday 16th November 09.00-12.00



The new heating in the main hall is now working – many thanks to Mark Holmes for all his efforts. There may be one or two minor adjustments to still be made but we now anticipate that everyone will be more than toasty!

As we stated previously the installation is taking place in Two Phases – Phase 1 is now concluded and Phase 2 (the installation of new Convector Storage heaters in the ancillary areas) is provisionally scheduled to commence before Christmas.
