Storm Amy Impact

Openreach did eventually show up, I am not quite sure why it took so long, but at least we appear to be all be back online. I know that many of you put pressure on your service providers and we did manage to get directly through to Openreach. We also had other organisations contact Openreach on the CC's behalf, namely the Argyll and Bute Council Resilience team, and our MSP's office, which may have speeded things up.

Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) and trees near power lines

As I mentioned last week, FLS are going to fell the trees just south of the village after the damage from Storm Eowyn, but they refused our request to cut back trees in the next section further south. This is the section where trees have brought down the power lines. We have written to them demanding that they cut that section of trees back away from the powerline. They have acknowledged our letter and await their reply.

If they are still unwilling to do so then we will look at escalating the issue through our Councillors and MSP.

Winter Bus Timetable and Calmac Ferry Timetable

I have attached the upcoming winter timetables for the bus and Calmac ferry, there are minor changes for us. Biggest issue is again the one boat service from Calmac. See the note attached from Dunoon Community Council that explains what is happening.

Village Hall Upgrades

The heating in the hall has now been modified to have a timer system.

- The two heaters nearest the door are set to half power
- The hall minimum temperature has been set to 14°C and is being maintained by the Hive unit via the middle two heaters
- The door and stage end heaters are hall user operated via the master switch and their individual heater time switches
- Each heater's on/off status can be seen at the light on the fused switch beside each heater
- Turning off the heating at the Master Switch kills all heaters (the middle pair will stay on if the Hall temperature is below 14 °C)

Please follow instructions in the hall. Any feedback would be appreciated to make sure it provides adequate heating for everyone
