Ardentinny Community Council News

Winter Bus Timetable and Calmac Ferry Timetable

Last week I attached the new winter timetables for the bus and Calmac ferry. We were told that minimal changes were made to our 489 service. Well, once we looked in detail that was found not to be the case. West Coast Motors have removed the evening service that arrived in the village around 20.30! Furthermore, the last bus out of the village is now at 21.17. No consultation was made with either Ardentinny or Kilmun Community Councils, the 20.30 bus now stops at Strone Primary School and returns to Dunoon to allow it to meet the Calmac ferry.

Of course, we will be challenging West Coast Motors on this, and we have already spoken with our Ward Councillors to get their support. We hope to liaise with Kilmun CC to present a joint case for reinstatement of the service. Yet again both residents and visitors are inconvenienced, and the night time economy (i.e. Strone, Inn, The Blairmore, The Ardentinny Bar and Bistro) along the shore takes a hit.

Remembrance Service – War Memorial Ardentinny

The Community Council intend to lay a wreath at the War memorial at 11.30am on Sunday 9th November. We are still hoping to do a joint event with the Minister if he is available, we will update you if the timing changes.

Squirrel Signs



Village Hall Upgrades

The "Snug" (our small meeting room) is now available to hire for small groups to meet at the hall without having to heat the whole hall. Cost of Hire:

£5 per hour for members £7 per hour for non-members £35 for a half day and £70 for a full day



The heating in the main hall has now been modified to have a timer system.

- The two heaters nearest the door are set to half power
- The hall minimum temperature has been set to 14°C and is being maintained by the Hive unit via the middle two heaters
- The door and stage end heaters are hall user operated via the master switch and their individual heater time switches
- Each heater's on/off status can be seen at the light on the fused switch beside each heater
- Turning off the heating at the Master Switch kills all heaters (the middle pair will stay on if the Hall temperature is below 14 °C)

Please follow instructions in the hall. Any feedback would be appreciated to make sure it provides adequate heating for everyone
