Ardentinny Community Council News

Ardentinny Community Council Public Meeting

Ardentinny Beach

We have recently had some discussions with Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) regarding visitor behaviour at the beach. You will remember this was one of the hottest topics needing addressed from the 2023 Residents Survey.

FLS advised us that if anyone who visits the beach and sees any inappropriate behaviour, such as damage to structures or the environment, dogs out of control, overenthusiastic alcohol consumption resulting in issues, lighting fires then you can call 101 and inform the Police, or alternatively make a report on the [Police Scotland website Contact Form](#). The more that such incidents at the beach are reported the more likely Police will visit as part of their standard patrol.

FLS also informed us that there are no Seasonal Rangers on patrol so they do not have anyone monitoring the beach area.

As always, the majority of our visitors do not cause a problem, but a small minority do.

Giants Burn Windfarm Presentation

Statkraft have agreed to give a presentation to Dunoon Community Council on Monday 9th September 2024. At 1900hrs in the main hall of the Queens Hall.

To avoid repeat questions, Dunoon Community Council have invited members of the public to submit questions by 26th August 2024, where they will carry out a sift and collate for the most common questions. They will then ask them on behalf of the public.
