# Roadworks – FLS road from village hall through to the Beach, work starts 13 May 2024

We have received a note from Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) indicating that starting Monday 13 May 2024 there will be Civil Engineering work on the road past the village hall to the beach. This will include pot hole patching in car park, installation of speed bumps, flood defence and tar patching on access road. The car park will be part closed during operations and traffic management will be in place during works. Work is planned to finish on 31 May 2024
