We received good news that we have been awarded funds for two defibrillators from the sale of the Highgate Hall. Thanks go to Neil Robinson and Anne Wood for writing up the successful applications on behalf of the Village Hall Management Team last year. One will be placed outside the Village Hall and the other at the FLS toilet block at the beach, once the funds have been released by the Highgate Hall Trustees.

#### UK General Election Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July

If you plan to vote, make sure you are registered to vote before Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June at 5pm. You can do it online here is the link; <u>Register to Vote</u> (make sure you choose Scotland as your location).

If you are planning to vote in person at a UK General Election you need to bring photo ID to the polling station, which is Ardentinny Village Hall. There are several different types of photo ID that you can use (e.g. Passport, Driving licence, National Entitlement Card (bus pass)). If you don't have any photo ID, you can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate instead – but make sure you do so before 5pm on Wednesday 26 June. Find out more and apply at

the Electoral Commission website (make sure you choose Scotland as your location).

If you're away on Polling Day, or can't get to a polling station in person, you still have other choices.

You can apply for a postal vote for this election before 5pm on Wednesday 19 June. Another option is to request a proxy vote, where someone else goes to the polling station to vote on your behalf. The deadline for proxy applications is 5pm on Wednesday 26 June.

The polling station will be open from 7am to 10pm at the Village Hall.

#### Roadworks – FLS road from village hall through to the Beach, work starts 13 May 2024

No progress on the works from Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) who indicated that starting Monday 13 May 2024 there will be Civil Engineering work on the road past the village hall to the beach. Apparently, there are issues with the contract between the Contractor and FLS which still need to be resolved. Will keep you posted if we hear any updates.

#### Proposed Windfarm - Giants Burn, Sandbank

You may have the seen a proposal for a windfarm development recently across social media and/or via a letter in the post. Public exhibitions have recently been held but if you missed them there is information on their webpage - www.giants-burn.co.uk

The proposed wind farm is located 2.1km north-west of Dunoon and 1.5km south-west of Sandbank.

Ardentinny Community Council would be interested in your views as residents, whether they be for or against the proposed windfarm. It would give us a feel for the general view of the village and could be useful if we are approached in the future as to the views of locals.
